### TERMS & CONDITIONS:

To the best of my/our knowledge these animals are in good health and free of communicable diseases including, but not limited to: Caseous Lymphadenitis (CL), Abscesses, Hoof Rot, Pneumonia, Mastitis, etc. Furthermore; I/we understand that a fecal float will be performed on each doe to determine parasite load. Does with a low FAMACHA score, high fecal egg count, and/or rough hair coat will be treated with an oral or topical de-wormer before exposure to our buck(s) in order to help maintain the health of our bucks and our herd. **We (Caprine Ridge Dairy Goats) have the right to refuse a doe for breeding if she is in poor condition or shows signs of illness in order to protect the health of our herd.** If a doe were to become ill, we will contact you and have our veterinarian perform necessary care; incurred expenses will be added to your bill. We will do the best to maintain and care for your doe(s) while on our farm, but we cannot be held liable for accidents or illnesses which could result in the possible death of your animal(s). In a worst-case scenario situation, we will refund the fee(s) associated with the involved animal(s); however, you would be responsible for any veterinary services.

- **You are expected to bring sufficient grain for your does for the duration of their stay.** We will provide care as well as hay and water.
- **Service Memos will be provided for all bred does.** ADGA members can choose to have their service memos filed online for ease of registering offspring.
